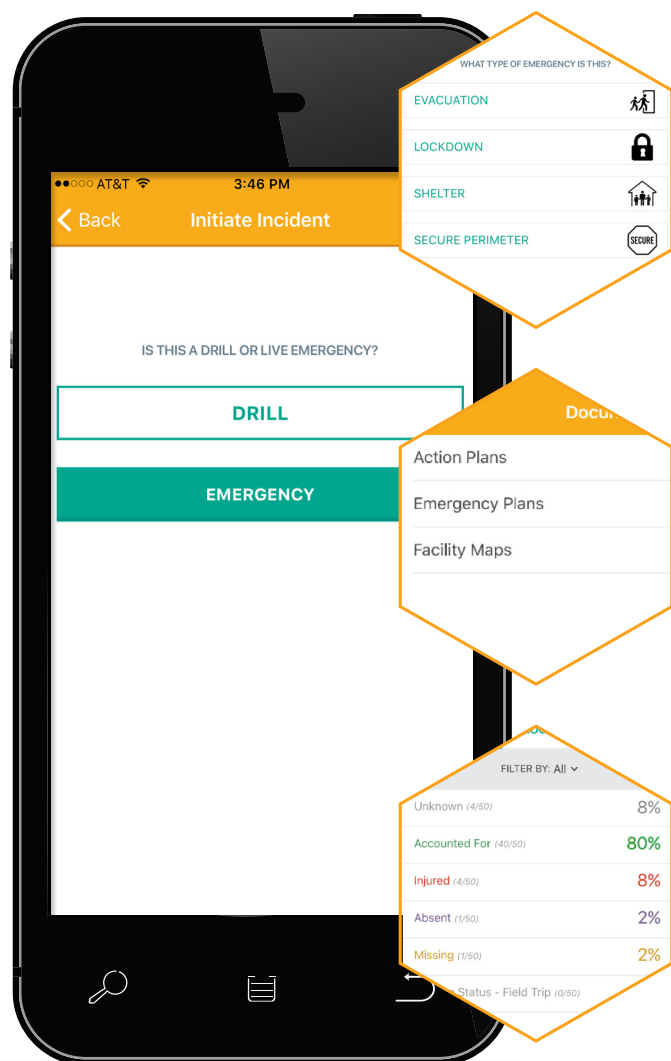

INITIATE AN ALERT

With the module's mobile app, any authorized user can initiate an emergency alert with the touch of a phone screen. Automated text, email, and smart phone alerts are instantly transmitted to all designated recipients, which can include all staff, key district personnel, and first responders.

ACCESS MAPS & PROCEDURES

First responders aren't always familiar with a school's layout, and some staff may not remember protocols. With the app users can quickly retrieve building maps and emergency plans directly to their mobile devices.

ACCOUNT FOR ALL STUDENTS & STAFF

Staff can instantly pull up student rosters from your synced SIS and confirm status and location of themselves and their students via their mobile devices. The data is sent in real time to incident commanders, giving full desktop visibility of the current status of everyone in the building. An events timeline for each student is recorded for post-incident reporting and accountability.

LOCK OUTSIDE DOORS.**

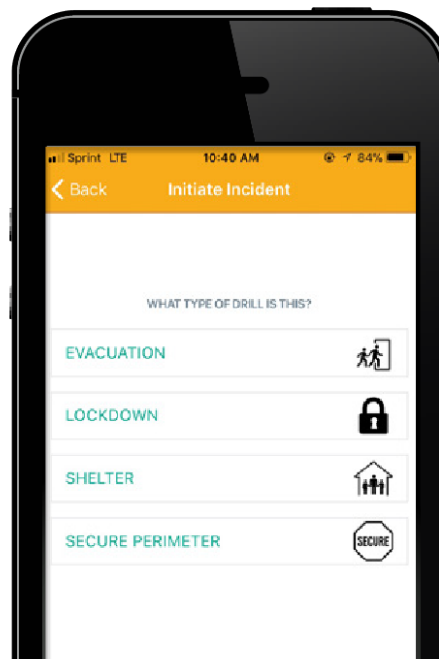
Lockout is called when there is a threat or hazard outside of the school building.
