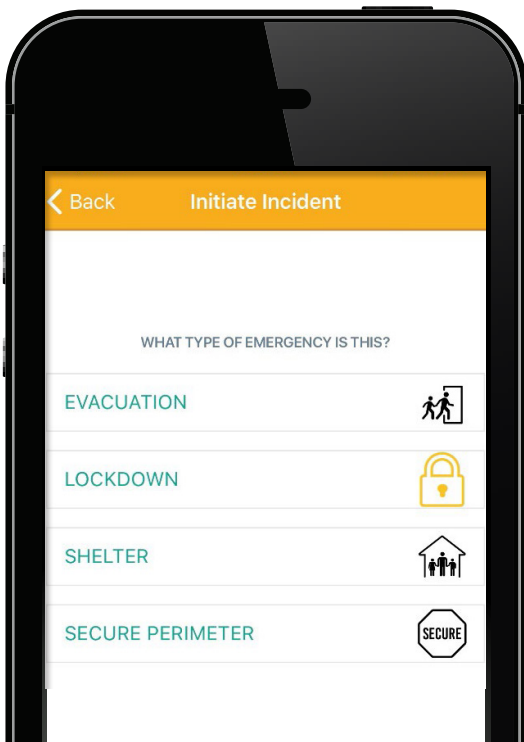

**Evacuate**

**EVACUATE TO A LOCATION**

Evacuate is called to move students and staff from one location to another.



**Lockdown**

**LOCKS, LIGHTS, OUT OF SIGHT**

Lockdown is called when there is a threat or hazard inside the school building.



**Shelter**

**SHELTER FOR A HAZARD USING SAFETY STRATEGY**

Shelter is called when the need for personal protection is necessary.

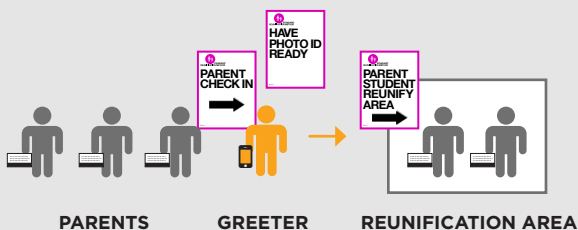


**Lockout / Secure Perimeter**

**GET INSIDE. LOCK OUTSIDE DOORS.**

Lockout is called when there is a threat or hazard outside of the school building.





## Step 1:

### Greeting, check-in, and ID verification

As parents arrive at the reunification site, greeters hand over a **process explanation card**, receive information from the parent on which student(s) he/she is picking up, and verify the parent's ID (the SRM information card completion is unnecessary, because the pertinent info is contained in the Raptor system). Greeters instruct parents to move to the reunification area following check-in.

## Step 2:

### Reunification communication

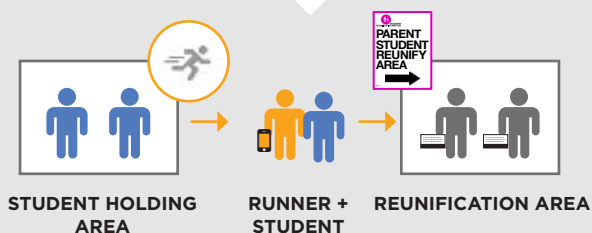
After the parent checks in with the greeter and moves to the reunification area, a runner is notified **via the Raptor mobile app** that the student's parent has arrived and that the student is ready to be reunified.



## Step 3:

### Student retrieval

The runner retrieves the student from the student holding area and then escorts the student to the reunification area.



## Step 4:

### Parent-student reunification

The runner arrives at the reunification area with the student, asking the student whether he/she is comfortable leaving with the parent. Upon identification confirmation, **the parent signs electronically in the app**, and the parent and student are then free to leave. An electronic log of the entire reunification process is captured in the system and is available to download for reporting and accountability.
